INVOCATION

P: In the name of the Father and of the † Son and the Holy Spirit.

C: Amen.

CALL TO WORSHIP

P: I waited patiently for the Lord; He turned to me and heard my cry.

C: He lifted me out of the slimy pit, out of the mud and mire; He set my feet on a rock and gave me a firm place to stand.

P: He put a new song in my mouth, a hymn of praise to our God. Many will see, fear and put their trust in the Lord.

C: Blessed is the man who makes the Lord his trust, who does not look to the proud; to those who turn aside to false gods.

P: O Lord My God, the wonders You have done. The things You planned for us no one can recount to You; where I to speak and tell of them, they would be too many to declare.

C: Sacrifice and offering You did not desire, but my ears You have pierced; burnt offerings and sin offerings, You did not require.

P: Then I said, "Here I am, I have come - it is written about me in the scroll.

C: I desire to do Your will, O my God. Your law is within my heart."

P: I proclaim righteousness in the great assembly; I do not seal my lips, as You know, O Lord.

C: I do not hide Your righteousness in my heart; I speak of Your faithfulness and salvation. I do not conceal Your love and Your truth from the great assembly.

P: Do not withhold Your mercy from me, O Lord;

C: may Your love and Your truth always protect me. Amen.

CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

P: Remembering the new beginning God gives through the waters of baptism, we remember the words of the Psalmist; "Surely I have been a sinner from birth,

C: sinful from the time my mother conceived me."

P: Therefore, "If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us." *(1 John 1:8)*

C: "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." *(1 John 1:9)*

P: Let us then confess our sins in the words of David.

C: "Have mercy on me, O God, according to Your unfailing love; according to Your great compassion, blot out my transgressions. Wash away all my iniquity and cleanse me from my

sin. For I know my transgressions, and my sin is always before me. Against You, You only, have I sinned and done what is evil in Your sight, so that You are proved right when You speak and justified when You judge. Cleanse me with hyssop, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow. Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me." (Psalm 51:1-4, 7, 10)

P: Lift up our hearts! God has had mercy upon us. He sent Jesus to take our place from the very beginning. He too was conceived in a womb, but without sin. He took our place on the cross and in a tomb. His resurrection assures us of a new beginning! Therefore, as a called and ordained servant of the Word, I, therefore, forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the ☩ Son and of the Holy Spirit.

P: The Lord be with you.

THE OLD TESTAMENT READING

Reader: Isaiah 62:1-5 For Zion's sake I will not keep silent, and for Jerusalem's sake I will not be quiet, until her righteousness goes forth as brightness, and her salvation as a burning torch. ²The nations shall see your righteousness, and all the kings your glory, and you shall be called by a new name that the mouth of the LORD will give. ³You shall be a crown of beauty in the hand of the LORD, and a royal diadem in the hand of your God. ⁴You shall no more be termed Forsaken, and your land shall no more be termed Desolate, but you shall be called My Delight Is in Her, and your land Married; for the LORD delights in you, and your land shall

be married. ⁵For as a young man marries a young woman, so shall your sons marry you, and as the bridegroom rejoices over the bride, so shall your God rejoice over you.

Reader: This is the word of the Lord.

C: Thanks be to God.

THE EPISTLE READING

Reader: 1 Corinthians 12:1-11 Now concerning spiritual gifts, brothers, I do not want you to be uninformed. ²You know that when you were pagans you were led astray to mute idols, however you were led. ³Therefore I want you to understand that no one speaking in the Spirit of God ever says "Jesus is accursed!" and no one can say "Jesus is Lord" except in the Holy Spirit. ⁴Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; ⁵and there are varieties of service, but the same Lord; ⁶and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who empowers them all in everyone. ⁷To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. ⁸For to one is given through the Spirit the utterance of wisdom, and to another the utterance of knowledge according to the same Spirit, ⁹to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit, ¹⁰to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another the ability to distinguish between spirits, to another various kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. ¹¹All these are empowered by one and the same Spirit, who apportions to each one individually as he wills.

Reader: This is the word of the Lord.

C: Thanks be to God.

THE HOLY GOSPEL

P: Today's Gospel reading is from the book of John, chapter 2 beginning at the 1st verse.

C: Glory to You, O Lord.

P: On the third day there was a wedding at Cana in Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. ²Jesus also was invited to the wedding with his disciples. ³When the wine ran out, the mother of Jesus said to him, "They have no wine." ⁴And Jesus said to her, "Woman, what does this have to do with me? My hour has not yet come." ⁵His mother said to the servants, "Do whatever he tells you." ⁶Now there were six stone water jars there for the Jewish rites of purification, each holding twenty or thirty gallons. ⁷Jesus said to the servants, "Fill the jars with water." And they filled them up to the brim. ⁸And he said to them, "Now draw some out and take it to the master of the feast." So they took it. ⁹When the master of the feast tasted the water now become wine, and did not know where it came from (though the servants who had drawn the water knew), the master of the feast called the bridegroom ¹⁰and said to him, "Everyone serves the good wine first, and when people have drunk freely, then the poor wine. But you have kept the good wine until now." ¹¹This, the first of his signs, Jesus did at Cana in Galilee, and manifested his glory. And his disciples believed in him.

P: This is the Gospel of the Lord.

C: Praise to You, O Christ.

AFFIRMATION OF FAITH- NICENE CREED

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth. And of all things visible and invisible. And in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only-begotten Son of God, begotten of his Father before all worlds, God of God, Light of Light, very God of very God, begotten not made, being of one substance with the Father, by whom all things were made; who for us men and for our salvation

came down from heaven and was incarnate by the Holy Spirit of the virgin Mary and was made man; and was crucified also for us under Pontius Pilate. He suffered and was buried. And the third day he rose again according to the Scriptures and ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of the Father. And he will come again with glory to judge both the living and the dead, whose kingdom will have no end. And I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord and giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son together is worshiped and glorified, who spoke by the prophets. And I believe in one holy Christian and apostolic Church, I acknowledge one Baptism for the remission of sins, and I look for the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.
